As you know the field now forms part of the new Bourne Academy and will become a school playing field later next year. The Council's responsibility to maintain the field ceased when the tenancy transferred to the Bourne Academy.

During the week discussion have taken place between the Academy and the Council, regarding the growing problem of discarded bags. I am pleased to inform you that the school have asked the Council to continue maintaining the field until March 2012. When, they hope to submit their planning application for the new school build.
