Dear Redhill Drive Resident,

I am writing to give you an update on the progress made since the meeting in Redhill Pavilion on 22nd September. The meeting was held due to the rise in complaints of anti-social behaviour since the installation of the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA).

Many of you also signed the petition asking for the benches adjacent to the MUGA to be removed.

On 12th October, a Local resident and I presented your petition to the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet. On the same day a follow up meeting was held at Winton Police station with officers from Parks, Youth Service and Police Safer Neighbourhood Team.

Yesterday I received confirmation that the benches will be removed in the next week!

Last night we had a meeting with the Young People in Redhill Pavilion, they put forward many different ideas including organised sporting events they would like to have. Hopefully some of their ideas can be progressed depending on funding being available.

I would like to thank everyone who signed the petition, hopefully the late night disturbances will now subside.
